The document looks at key policy areas affecting the development of SMEs in China such as access to financing, reduction of the administrative and financial burden, innovation and entrepreneurship, Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) protection and SME internationalisation, among others. The report highlights the positive developments in terms of SME policy formulation and implementation and also looks at the challenges ahead and areas where there is room for improvement, especially from the perspective of European small businesses.
